1.4 DELIVERY, STORAGE, AND HANDLING

- A. Delivery: Deliver materials to site in manufacturer's original, unopened containers and packaging, with labels clearly identifying manufacturer and product name.
- B. Storage: Store materials in a clean, dry area indoors in accordance with manufacturer's instructions. Keep containers sealed until ready for use. Keep away from ignition sources. Do not allow to freeze.
- C. Handling: Protect materials during handling and application to prevent damage or contamination.

1.5 ENVIRONMENTAL REQUIREMENTS

A. Do not apply wax when air or surface temperature is below 55 degrees F.

PART 3 EXECUTION

3.1 EXAMINATION

A. Examine surfaces to receive wax. Notify Architect if surfaces are not acceptable. Do not begin surface preparation or application until unacceptable conditions have been corrected.

3.2 SURFACE PREPARATION

A. Prepare surface in accordance with manufacturer's instructions.

B. Ensure surface is clean, dry, and free from dirt, dust, stain residue, and other surface contaminants.

- A. Apply and buff wax in accordance with manufacturer's instructions at locations indicated on the drawings.
- B. Keep material containers closed when not in use to avoid contamination.

3.4 PROTECTION

A. Protect waxed floor surface from damage during construction.
